Peter & Bunny Flint requested that the Selectboard discontinue Burbank Crossroad. The road is in disrepair and having people turning around at their house at all hours of the day and night disrupts their lives. The Flints own all property on both sides of the road from the Hook Road to the East Randolph Road and are willing to take over all responsibility for maintenance of the Class 3 section that serves as their driveway in exchange for having the road discontinued. Following a viewing of the road, the meeting reconvened at the Town Hall. Issues of concern include the fact that the entire state is closing down to recreational and other travel, discussion re: ancient roads, the Selectboard receiving an overwhelming number of messages against making any changes in the status of any road in Chelsea and the fact that the Planning Commission is in the process of rewriting the town plan which includes transportation issues. Following discussion, Carol moved and Dick seconded the motion to do nothing to change the status of any roads in Chelsea at this time and to follow through with the Planning Commission as they study transportation issues and renewed interest in ancient roads. So moved.

Ancient Roads will be discussed at a later date. Larry Allen is willing to serve on an Ancient Roads Committee.
