TOWN OF CHELSEA TRAFFIC ORDINANCE

Pursuant to the provisions of Title 18 V.S.A § 1324, Title 23 V.S.A. § 1007 & 1008 and Title 24, V.S.A. § 1971 and 2291 (1), (4) and (5) Title 19, V.S.A. § 1109 & 1110; and such other enactments as may be material hereto; it is hereby ordained by the Selectboard of the Town of Chelsea that this Traffic Ordinance is adopted for the Town of Chelsea.

ARTICLE I DEFINITIONS

The definitions in Title 23 V.S.A. § 4 are incorporated by reference.

ARTICLE II SCOPE

This ordinance establishes special traffic regulations on public highways within the Town of Chelsea, Vermont.

ARTICLE III TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES

- Section 1: It shall be unlawful for any person to disobey the direction of a traffic control device except in response to the direction of a law enforcement officer.
- Section 2: It shall be unlawful for any person to intentionally remove, injure, obstruct, deface, alter or tamper with any traffic control device.
- Section 3: It shall be unlawful to install any sign or device, which may resemble or be mistaken for an official traffic control device without prior approval of the Selectboard of the Town of Chelsea.

ARTICLE IV SPEED REGULATIONS

After considering the pedestrian, bicycle and horseback riding traffic and the sight distance and other physical characteristics, the maximum speed limit of all town highways, with the exceptions listed below, has been reduced to 35 m.p.h.

EXCEPTIONS

TH #1 (East Randolph Road) – A maximum speed of 40 M.P.H. beginning at the intersection of VT 110, extending westerly 2.89 miles to the Brookfield town line.

TH #2 (Upper Village Road) – A maximum speed of 40 m.p.h. beginning at the intersection of TH #15 (Washington Turnpike) extending northerly 0.71 mile to the end of the pavement.

TH #3 (Jenkins Brook Rd) – A maximum speed of 30 m.p.h. beginning at the junction of VT Rte. 110 extending easterly 1.43 miles to the intersection of TH #61 (Vershire Center Rd)

TH #30 (North Court Street) – A maximum speed of 25 m.p.h. beginning at the intersection of VT Rte. 110 extending easterly to the intersection of TH #46 (Court Street).

TH #46 (Court Street) – A maximum speed of 25 m.p.h. beginning at the intersection of VT Rte. 113 extending south to the intersection of TH #56 (School Street).

TH #56 (School Street) – A maximum speed of 25 m.p.h. beginning at the intersection of TH #46 (Court Street) extending west to the intersection of VT Rte. 110.

The Town of Chelsea has adopted the speed limits on VT Rte 110 and VT Rte 113 as signed by the State of Vermont.

VT Rte 110 – A maximum speed limit of 40 mph, beginning $0.21\pm$ miles south of TH #3 (Jenkins Brook Rd) and extending northerly $0.59\pm$ miles to a point $0.10\pm$ miles south of TH #43 (Beacon Hill Rd); and from this point a maximum speed limit of 30 mph, extending northerly 1.22 miles to a point $0.12\pm$ miles north of TH #2 (Upper Village Road; and from this point a maximum speed limit of 40 mph, extending northerly $0.34\pm$ miles to a point $0.04\pm$ miles north of Bridge #12. The speed limit on the remainder of VT Rte 110 is a maximum of 50 mph or as signed by the State of Vermont.

VT Rte 113 – A speed limit of 35 mph or 50 mph or as signed by the State of Vermont.

ARTICLE V STOP AND YIELD INTERSECTIONS

Section 1: The following intersections shall be designated as STOP or YIELD intersections and shall be so signed.

TH # 47 (Town Farm Rd) to TH #61 – STOP TH #73 (Jenkins Brook Rd) to TH #61 - STOP

TH #68 – MOXLEY ROAD

TH #69 (Bugbee Rd) to TH #68 – YIELD

Section 2. The following intersections shall be designated as STOP intersections as signed by the State of Vermont:

TH #8 (Edwards Rd) to VT Rte. 110 TH #4 (Bobbinshop Rd) to VT Rte. 110 TH #76 (North Common) to VT Rte. 110 TH #30 (North Court St) to VT Rte. 110 TH #77 (Creamery Rd) to VT Rte. 110 TH #3 (Jenkins Brook Rd) to VT Rte. 110 TH #68 (Moxley Rd) to VT Rte. 110 TH #68 (Moxley Rd) to VT Rte. 110 TH #30 (North Common) to VT Rte. 113 TH #47 (Densmore Rd) to VT Rte. 113 TH #28 (Lyford Dr) to VT Rte. 113 TH #57 (Scadin Rd) to VT Rte. 113 TH #2 (Upper Village Rd) to VT Rte. 110 TH #44 (Maple Ave) to VT Rte. 110 VT Rte. 113 to VT Rte. 110 TH #56 (School St) to VT Rte. 110 TH #43 (Beacon Hill Rd) to VT Rte. 110 TH #1(E. ARTICLE VI PARKING REGULATIONS

The following highways or portions thereof shall be designated as "NO PARKING ZONES":

TH #30 (North Court St) – On the north side between VT Rte 110 and TH #46 (Court St)

TH #46 (Court St) – On both sides of the bridge over Jail Brook

- TH #46 (Court St) On the westerly side, beginning at the intersection of TH #56 (School St), extending northerly a distance of 25 feet
- TH #56 (School St) On the northerly side, beginning at the intersection of TH # 46 (Court St) extending westerly a distance of 50 feet
- TH #56 (Highland Ave) On both sides, beginning at the intersection of TH #46 (Court St), extending Easterly a distance of 600 feet

From the intersection of VT Ret 110 to the footbridge to Riverside Cemetery on either side of the road. <u>TH #46 (Court Street) – From the intersection of TH #46(Court Street) and TH #56 (Highland Avenue) on the</u> north side of intersection 10 feet.

The following highways or portions thereof are designated as "NO PARKING" between November 15th and April 15th of each year from 12:00 midnight to 7:00 a.m.:

TH #30 (North Court St) – On south side between VT Rte 110 and TH #46 (Court St.) TH #46 (Court St) – On west side of street between a distance of 25 feet south of TH #30 (North Court St.) and 50 feet north of TH #56 (School St)

TH #56 (School St) – On the north side between VT Rte 110 and 50 feet west of TH #56 (Court St) TH #76 (Park St) – On the south and west side from VT Rte 110 and VT Rte 113

The following area is designated as "HANDICAP PARKING ONLY":

TH #76 (Park St) – On the north side from VT Rte. 110 easterly a distance of 25 feet

Pursuant to the provisions of Title 23 V.S.A.§ 1104, stopping is prohibited except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic, or in compliance with law or the directions of an enforcement officer or official traffic-control device, no person may stand or park a vehicle, whether occupied or not, except momentarily to pick up or discharge a passenger WITHIN SIX (6) FEET OF A FIRE HYDRANT.

ARTICLE VII POSTING OF HIGHWAYS

Pursuant to Title 19 V.S.A.§ 1109 and 1110, 2-axle vehicles over 15,000 lbs, 3-axle vehicles over 18,000 lbs and tractor trailers over 20,000 lbs are restricted from the following Town of Chelsea highways from March 1st to May 1st of each year except by special permission of the Selectboard or it's designee:

TH #3 (Class 2) – Brook Road	TH #3 (class 3) – Jenkins Brook Road/County Road
TH #4 – Bobbinshop Road/Williamstown Rd	TH #5 – Hopkin Road
TH #8 – Edwards Road	TH #11 – Gilman Hill Road
TH #15 – Washington Turnpike	TH #17 – Washington Turnpike

ARTICLE VIII ONE WAY STREETS

The following streets or portion of said streets are hereby designated as one-way and the direction of travel shall be as follows:

- 1. <u>TH #30 (No. Court Street) Legal direction of travel, from the intersection of TH #46 (Court Street)</u> shall be west to the intersection of VT Rte 110. From the intersection of TH #46 (Court Street) to the intersection of VT Rte 110 shall be two-way traffic.
- 2. <u>TH #46 (Court Street) Legal direction of travel, from the intersection of TH #56(School Street) shall</u> be north to the intersection of VT Rte 113.
- 3. TH #56 (School Street) Legal direction of travel, from the intersection of VT Rte 110 shall be east to the intersection of TH #46 (Court Street).

ARTICLE IX GENERAL PROVISIONS

- Section 1. Each violation of a provision of this ordinance shall be deemed a separate offense.
- Section 2. Each violation of a provision of this ordinance shall be deemed a civil violation.
- Section 3. A person who violates a provision of this ordinance shall be subject to prosecution and fines.
- Section 4. Penalties for a person who violates a parking provision of this ordinance shall be no less than ten (\$10.00) dollars) for each violation if paid in 30 days. If not paid in 30 days, the penalty_will be increased to \$25.00 plus court fees. All monies received hereunder for parking violations shall be paid to the treasurer of the Town of Chelsea as part of its general revenue.
- Section 5. Penalties for a person who violates a speed or sign provision of this ordinance shall be paid to the Judicial Bureau of Vermont.
- Section 6. The provisions of this ordinance are declared severable, and if any provision hereof is judged invalid, such judgment shall not affect the validity of any other provision.
- Section 7. This ordinance supercedes all previous traffic ordinances of the Town of Chelsea.

- Section 8. Reference is made to the General Highway Map of the Town of Chelsea, prepared by the Vermont Agency of Transportation, dated 1986, for highway designations.
- Section 9. This ordinance is amended on June 10, 2008, and shall become effective in 60 days.

Pursuant to the provisions of Title 24 V.S.A. § 1973, the citizens of the Town of Chelsea have the right to petition for a vote on the amended ordinance by presenting a petition signed by not less than 5% of the qualified voters to the Town Clerk or the Selectboard within 44 days following the date of adoption. If no petition is presented, this amended ordinance shall become effective on August 9, 2008.
