# Research: Payment Methods

#### Surrounding towns:

- Punch cards: Vershire, Tunbridge, Norwich, Hartford, Sharon,
   Lebanon
- **Customized trash bags:** non-lebanon residents using lebanon transfer station
- Cash/Check: Williamstown, Northfield, Corinth (managed by Casella),
   White River Alliance, Thetford



### Solution # 1: Punch Cards

Cash/check will no longer accepted. Pre-purchased punch cards must be brought to the transfer station for disposal of trash or use of construction dumpsters.

#### PURCHASING

- O Town Clerk's office
- Will's store
  - \*\*eventually\*\* on the town website

#### PRICING

- \$30 for a 10-punch card: each punch = \$3
- \$50 for a 10-punch card: each punch = \$5
- \$100 for 20-punch card: each punch= \$5 ideal for use of construction dumpster (Available only at town clerk's office)

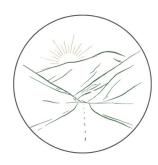
#### **Punch conversions:**

- $\circ$  up to 15-gallon bag = (1) \$3-punch
- o 30-gallon bag= (1) \$5-punch
- 45-gallon bag= (2) \$3-punches
- 65-gallon containers= (3) \$3-punches

# Research: Recycling

#### Surrounding towns:

- **Per bag:** White River Alliance (Barnard, Bethel, Granville, Hancock, Rochester, Royalton, Stockbridge), Northfield, Williamstown (\$2.50-3/bag)
- **Free:** Tunbridge
- **Annual sticker/permit:** Corinth, Norwich, Hartford, Thetford



# Solution #2: Recycling Stickers

- Annual stickers will be required for the use of recycling services at the Transfer Station.
- Stickers will be valid for 1 full year from the date of purchase.

#### PURCHASING

- Town Clerk's office
- Will's store
- \*\*eventually\*\* on the town website

#### • PRICING

\$40 per sticker, valid through January 1

#### **Cost Comparison:**

40/year = <1/week



### Forecasted gains: Recycling Stickers

Currently, residents subsidize recycling costs for non-residents as taxes

~529 year-round, non-commercial residents in Chelsea

#### Estimated revenue at \$40/sticker:

- 100% of residents purchase stickers= \$21,160
  - Nearly cover annual recycling expense
- 46% of residents (243) purchase stickers = \$9,720
  - Nearly cover transfer station deficit

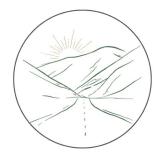

# Financial Report Summary

- o 2020≫ 2021
  - 6.1% **increase** in construction/solid waste <u>expenses</u>
  - 1.3% increase in solid waste revenue
- o 2021» 2022:
  - 14.5% **increase** in construction/solid waste <u>expenses</u>
  - 1.4% **decrease** in solid waste <u>revenue</u>

<u>Trend:</u> increased expenses, stagnant revenue



# Solution # 3: Updated Pricing

Compared pricing to 11 Vermont towns

Targeting furniture/mattresses

Adjusting to match punch-card structure

15 items (+\$0.50-3)

New pricing structure= overall ~3.7% increase in average per-item cost (excludes bagged trash)

# Legality

- 2018 Legislative Changes to Vermont Solid Waste & Bottle Bill Laws
  - Senate Bill S.260 and S.285 (combined changes from S.285 and S.287) were passed into law
    at the end of May 2018 which made changes to Vermont's Universal Recycling law and
    Beverage Container Redemption law.
  - "Solid waste facilities are now able to charge a separate fee for collection of recyclables"
  - "Haulers (including "fast trash" haulers) are not able to charge a separate fee for collection of recyclables but can charge a bundled fee that covers both trash and recycling costs. Fast trash haulers can turn away customers that seek only recycling services without bringing in any trash. This has been an existing requirement and did not change."

#### **GUVSWMD**

- Greater Upper Valley Solid Waste Management District
  - Serves: Bridgewater, Hartland, Norwich, Pomfret, Sharon, Strafford, Thetford, Vershire, West Fairlee, & Woodstock
  - GUVSWMD does not run Hartford Transfer station though all members of GUVSWMD may use it.



#### Hartford

- Hartford Transfer Station/Recycling Center
  - Punch cards-\$47.50 (10 punches, 13+gal bag= 1 punch)
  - Windshield Stickers \$30 (\$15/each additional)
  - Used by: Bridgewater, Hartland, Norwich, Pomfret, Sharron, Strafford, Thetford, Vershire, West Fairlee, 

    ଔ Woodstock



#### Lebanon

- Lebanon, NH Solid Waste and Recycling Facility
  - o Trash:
    - Punch cards only- \$20 = 10 punches (residents only)
    - $Prepaid bags (\$10 = 5 \times 30 \text{gal OR } 10 = 15 \text{gal})$
  - Residential permits= \$15, required for punch card purchase and recycling services
  - Used by: Bridgewater, Canaan, Enfield, Fairless, Grafton, Hanover, Hartford, Hartland, Lyme, Newbury, Norwich, Orange, Orford, Plainfield, Pomfret, Sharon, Strafford, Thetford, Vershire, West Fairlee, Woodstock.



#### Norwich

- Norwich VT
  - Norwich Transfer Station
    - Recycling/Compost: Annual Windshield Permit \$25 for resident; \$50 for non-resident
    - Trash: "Coupons" \$35/10 coupons (\$3.50/bag 30-gal or less)
  - OR: Hartford Transfer/Recycling Center, Lebanon,
     NH Solid Waste and Recycling Facility



#### Thetford

- Thetford VT
  - Thetford Transfer Station
    - Recycling/Trash: \$25 permit
    - Trash: serviced by Quinttown Container Service, cash or check
  - OR: Lebanon, NH Solid Waste and Recycling Facility,
     Hartford Transfer Station/Recycling Center



# Tunbridge

- Tunbridge VT Transfer Station
  - Recycling/Compost: no charge
  - Trash: punch cards
    - \$30- 10 x \$3 punch (large bags/ barrels)
    - \$20= 10 x \$2 punch (mid size bags, car tires)
    - \$10= 10 x 1\$ punch (small bags)



### Woodstock

- A.B.L.E. Waste Management
- OR: Lebanon, NH Solid Waste and Recycling Facility,
   Hartford Transfer Station/Recycling Center



#### Vershire

- Town of Vershire Transfer Station
  - Trash: Phasing out trash green bags » Punch cards
    - $$20 = 20 \times $1 \text{ punch.}$ 
      - 15-gal= 1 punch, 30-gal = 3 punches,contractor = 6 punches
  - Recycling- Free
- OR: Lebanon, NH Solid Waste and Recycling Facility,
   Hartford Transfer Station/Recycling Center



### Royalton

- Royalton Solid Waste Facility
  - Serves: Barnard, Bethel, Granville, Hancock,
     Rochester, Royalton, Stockbridge
  - Trash: cash accepted
  - Recycling: \$3/visit» price per bag
    - \$3/30-gal, \$4.50/contractor
