Present: Linda Kuban, Jen, Chase, Susan Elder, Kate Willard, Robin Amber, Pete Amber, Marty Gratz and John Latham attended by Google groups call.

Robin asked that we keep a "public comment" section on every agenda as questions come up from the public periodically.

Susan updated the group on the status of the Pollinator grant. She will attend the selectboard meeting tomorrow night to get final ok from the Board. The grant has been submitted but can be withdrawn if necessary. The grant application states that decisions will come in May or June and we have over one year to complete the project. Susan will also ask selectboard about policy of driving onto greens and if there is an exemption made for flea market. Susan will also ask Phyllis Hayward and other organizers to our next meeting to discuss reduction on vehicle use on the greens.

Jen asked for input on a spring fundraiser idea such as Memorial/donated trees, plants, bulbs, and benches on FEMA lands or greens. The Chelsea Health Center memorial tree walk project is similar to what we want. Can we coordinate with their board? They will be contacted to discuss. Benches needed could be part of the collaboration with the school's woodshop class. We should at least buy local. Benches can be very expensive.

Jen wanted to know if the group was interested in a spring clean up of Town greens and other properties. It was decided to coordinate with Tim Courts and other Green Up Day organizers to formulate a plan for April 4th. Kate will work on this.

Town Forest Trails. It was decided that we would contact Andy Pomerantz to set a date for Town Forest walk. Is there a possible parking area solution? Group will bring forest plan and town maps to review layout of land. Kate will organize this visit.

It was decided that our future meeting notices will include an invitation to attend via zoom if so desired.
